We can also assist parents to complete the Secondary subsidy form if your child is eligible.

The Secondary Assistance Subsidy of **\$235.00** is deducted from the Voluntary Contributions in Year 7 to 10 and from Compulsory Course Charges in Years 11 and 12. The intent of the subsidy is to make Government secondary education more affordable for parents and improve retention rates in the Post-compulsory years.
